PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Progressing Rural Economic  
Prosperity Fund; transferring and appropriating  
funds; establishing amounts and sources; specifying  
purpose; and providing for noncodification.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services  
shall transfer on the effective date of this act the sum of One  
Hundred Forty-five Million Dollars (\$145,000,000.00) of the funds  
appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce by Section 1 of  
Enrolled House Bill No. 1038 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the  
59th Oklahoma Legislature to the Progressing Rural Economic

1 Prosperity Fund created in Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma  
2 Statutes, to be budgeted and expended in accordance with law.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
4 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

5 There is hereby appropriated to the Progressing Rural Economic  
6 Prosperity Fund created in Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma  
7 Statutes from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General  
8 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June  
9 30, 2024, the sum of One Hundred Five Million Dollars  
10 (\$105,000,000.00) to be budgeted and expended in accordance with  
11 law.
