PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to insurance; permitting recovery of
damages by insured individuals in certain cases;
defining term; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6860 of Title 36, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Insured individuals in the State of Oklahoma may bring civil
action to recover damages against an insurer who acts in
demonstrable bad faith pertaining to the insurer's decisions about
referral of said insured to health care providers. As used in this
act, the term "bad faith" shall include an insurer who unreasonably
refuses referral to a health care provider capable of delivering
optimal care.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
