16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2021, Section 5-213, as
18	amended by Section 1, Chapter 253, O.S.L. 2022 (29 O.S. Supp. 2022,
19	Section 5-213), is amended to read as follows:
20	Section 5-213. A. The use of crossbows and conventional
21	longbows with a device that permits the bow to be held mechanically
22	at full or partial draw, shall be a legal hunting method during any
23	open season when conventional longbows are a legal means of take.

1 в. The use of air bows shall be a legal hunting method during 2 any open season when rifles are a legal means of take during the annual period extending from the beginning of deer muzzleloader 3 season to the end of the holiday antlerless deer gun season. No 4 5 person may hunt or take during the open season with an air bow unless the person has first obtained a stamp issued by the Oklahoma 6 Wildlife Conservation Commission for a one-time fee of Twenty 7 8 Dollars (\$20.00). 9 C. Notwithstanding the limitation provided in subsection B, a 10 person may use an air bow as a legal hunting method for predators or 11 nuisance wildlife including feral swine, regardless of hunting 12 season. 13 D. At such time as the Federal Aid in Wildlife Restoration Act 14 is amended to expand the excise tax on sporting arms and ammunition 15 to include air bows and air guns, the stamp pursuant to subsection B 16 of this section shall no longer be required, and authorization for 17 the continual use of air bows as a legal means of take shall be 18 established by rules promulgated by the Commission. 19 20 59-1-8190 MKS 04/12/23 21 22 23 24
