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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 1-106.2, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 1-106.2 A. By January 1, 1999, the <u>The</u> State Board
18	<u>Commissioner</u> of Health shall promulgate rules necessary to develop a
19	uniform application which shall be used in the credentialing process
20	of health care providers. The State Department of Health shall
21	develop such application form for:
22	1. Initial privileges or membership in a hospital, managed care
23	organization, or other entity requiring credentials verification,
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1  except for a contracted entity as defined by Section 4002.2 of Title
2  56 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and
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- 2. Recredentialing or reappointment in a hospital, managed care organization, or other entity requiring credentials verification, except for a contracted entity as defined by Section 4002.2 of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- B. Any entity requiring credentials verification may require supplemental information.
- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5071 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall establish and maintain for providers of Medicaid services:
 - A provider enrollment and credentialing process for providers who receive fee-for-service reimbursement under the state Medicaid program; and
 - 2. A single consolidated provider enrollment and credentialing process, in accordance with subsection D of Section 4002.4 of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes and 42 C.F.R., Section 438.214, for providers who enter into capitated contracts with contracted entities under the Ensuring Access to Medicaid Act.
- SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
