17	the United States shall acquire title to or own land in <del>the State of</del>
18	Oklahoma this state either directly or indirectly through a business
19	entity or trust, except as hereinafter provided, but he or she shall
20	have and enjoy in <del>the State of Oklahoma</del> <u>this state</u> such rights as to
21	personal property as are, or shall be accorded a citizen of the
22	United States under the laws of the nation to which such alien
23	belongs, or by the treaties of such nation with the United States,
24	except as the same may be affected by the provisions of <del>this act</del>
