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    Health. The program shall help increase the number of adolescent
    psychiatric beds available in Oklahoma. The program shall help
    provide funding for remodeling or building out existing facility
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    space to be used for an adolescent psychiatric facility.
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    program shall be used for facilities where a Public Trust Hospital,
    as defined in Sections 3250.1 through 3250.9 of Title 63 of the

    Oklahoma Statutes, are donating both the space and the staffing
    needs to support the facility. Applicants shall have, in writing,
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    the agreed upon support from the donating Public Trust Hospital upon
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    application. The location of these facilities shall be in counties
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    with a population of less than forty-five thousand (45,000) people
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    per the 2020 Federal Decennial Census. The facility, upon
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    completion, shall hold between ten and twenty beds for adolescent
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    psychiatric patients upon completion. Beginning January 1, 2025,
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    the State Department of Health shall provide an annual report to the
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    Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the
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    President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, the
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    Appropriations and Budget Chair of the Oklahoma House of
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    Representatives, and the Appropriations Chair of the State Senate
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    that includes information about any grants awarded and where
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    awardees are on the completion of the projects.

there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the State Department of Health to be designated the "Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the State Department of Health from appropriations to the fund. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State Department of Health for the purpose of the Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant Program. The State Department of Health may retain one percent (1%) of all funds otherwise deposited to the fund to cover administrative costs related to the Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant Program. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
