COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the State Department of Health;  
creating the Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility  
Grant Program; placing the program at a certain  
agency; providing purpose; requiring certain reports;  
establishing the Adolescent Psychiatric Facility  
Revolving Fund; establishing fund nature; authorizing  
certain budgeting and expenditure of funds for  
certain purposes; providing for codification;  
providing an effective date; and declaring an  
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3240.9 of Title 63, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma  
Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant Program".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3420.10 of Title 63, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created the Adolescent Psychiatric Facility  
Grant Program which shall be administered by the State Department of

1 Health. The program shall help increase the number of adolescent  
2 psychiatric beds available in Oklahoma. The program shall help  
3 provide funding for remodeling or building out existing facility  
4 space to be used for an adolescent psychiatric facility. The  
5 program shall be used for facilities where a Public Trust Hospital,  
6 as defined in Sections 3250.1 through 3250.9 of Title 63 of the  
7 Oklahoma Statutes, are donating both the space and the staffing  
8 needs to support the facility. Applicants shall have, in writing,  
9 the agreed upon support from the donating Public Trust Hospital upon  
10 application. The location of these facilities shall be in counties  
11 with a population of less than forty-five thousand (45,000) people  
12 per the 2020 Federal Decennial Census. The facility, upon  
13 completion, shall hold between ten and twenty beds for adolescent  
14 psychiatric patients upon completion. Beginning January 1, 2025,  
15 the State Department of Health shall provide an annual report to the  
16 Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the  
17 President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, the  
18 Appropriations and Budget Chair of the Oklahoma House of  
19 Representatives, and the Appropriations Chair of the State Senate  
20 that includes information about any grants awarded and where  
21 awardees are on the completion of the projects.

22 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3240.11 of Title 63, unless  
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1       There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
2 for the State Department of Health to be designated the "Adolescent  
3 Psychiatric Facility Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a  
4 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall  
5 consist of all monies received by the State Department of Health  
6 from appropriations to the fund. All monies accruing to the credit  
7 of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and  
8 expended by the State Department of Health for the purpose of the  
9 Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant Program. The State  
10 Department of Health may retain one percent (1%) of all funds  
11 otherwise deposited to the fund to cover administrative costs  
12 related to the Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant  
13 Program. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants  
14 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by  
15 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
16 Services for approval and payment.

17       SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

18       SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
19 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
