COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
21 O.S. 2021, Section 1192, which relates to the
unlawful spread of infectious diseases; specifying
additional infectious diseases; updating language;
and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1192, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 1192. Any person who shall inoculate himself or herself
or any other person or shall suffer himself or herself to be
inoculated with ~~smallpox, syphilis or gonorrhea~~:

1. Smallpox;

2. Syphilis;

3. Gonorrhea;

4. Chlamydia;

5. Hepatitis B;

6. Genital herpes;

1 7. Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Infection; or

2 8. Trichomoniasis,

3 and shall spread or cause to be spread to any other persons with
4 intent to or recklessly be responsible for the spread of or
5 prevalence of such infectious disease, shall, upon conviction, be
6 ~~deemed a felon, and, upon conviction thereof,~~ guilty of a felony and
7 ~~shall be punished~~ punishable by imprisonment in the State
8 Penitentiary custody of the Department of Corrections for a term of
9 not more than five (5) years nor less than two (2) years.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
