19	statement of a licensed physician stating that the physical
20	condition of the child is such that immunization would endanger the
21	life or health of the child; or upon receipt of a written statement
22	by the parent or guardian objecting to such immunizations because of
23	religious or other reasons for reasons of conscience, including a
