7	SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION
8	An Act relating to playground equipment; defining terms; requiring all public playground equipment be
9	to a certain standard; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7350 of Title 63, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	As used in this act:
17	1. "Fully inclusive" means anyone that may require the use of a
18	mobility device to access or use the playground equipment; and
19	2. "Travel surfaces" means the material in contact with the
20	ground that is used by individuals to navigate the playground.
21	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7351 of Title 63, unless there
23	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1	Every city, town, municipality, and public school district in
2	counties in Oklahoma with a population over one hundred thousand,
3	according to the latest Federal Decennial Census, that plan to:
4	1. Install new playground equipment and travel surfaces; or
5	2. Update existing playground equipment and travel surfaces,
6	shall ensure that all material and equipment are fully inclusive and
7	accessible for adults and children of all ages.
8	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
