10 An Act relating to mental health; amending 43A O.S.  
11 2021, Section 10-111.1, which relates to vulnerable  
12 adult abuse, neglect and exploitation; requiring the  
13 Office of the Attorney General to establish and  
maintain a certain registry; requiring quarterly  
update of registry; specifying information to be  
included in registry; and providing an effective  
date.

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16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2021, Section 10-111.1,

18 is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 10-111.1 A. On or before January 1, 2019 2024, the  
20 Office of the Attorney General shall ~~promulgate~~ establish and  
21 maintain the Vulnerable Adult Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation ~~Report~~  
Registry, accessible to the public ~~on the Internet~~ in an electronic  
22 format ~~that is easily and readily searchable~~ updated quarterly, to  
23 address:

1       1. A procedure for recording individuals on the registry who  
2       have been found guilty by a court of law or entered a plea of guilty  
3       or nolo contendere to a charge of abuse, neglect or exploitation of  
4       a vulnerable adult; and

5       2. Disclosure requirements for information that is accessible  
6       on the registry.

7       B. The Vulnerable Adult Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation

8       Registry shall include but not be limited to:

9       1. The full name of the individual;  
10      2. Information necessary to identify the individual;  
11      3. The disposition and other identifying case information  
12      regarding convictions or confessions of abuse, neglect or  
13      exploitation in a court of law; and

14      4. The date the individual was convicted or pled guilty or nolo  
15      contendere.

16      B. The report created in subsection A of this section shall be  
17      maintained by the Office of the Attorney General and shall include a  
18      list of defendants who have been prosecuted by the Office of the  
19      Attorney General and have been found guilty by a court of law for  
20      abuse, exploitation or neglect of elderly or vulnerable adults in  
21      the preceding twelve (12) months. The report shall be provided to  
22      the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the  
23      President Pro Tempore of the Senate on an annual basis beginning  
24      January 31, 2019. The report shall include, but not be limited to:

- 1       1. The name of the defendant;
- 2       2. The crime for which the defendant was convicted;
- 3       3. A description of the findings of abuse, neglect or
- 4       exploitation by the Office of the Attorney General, including the
- 5       circumstances surrounding the abuse;
- 6       4. The date of conviction or the date that a plea of guilty or
- 7       nolo contendere was accepted by the court;
- 8       5. The relationship of the defendant to the victim; and
- 9       6. The county where the offense or offenses occurred.

10      SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
