16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 582, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 582. There is hereby re-created, to continue until July
19	1, 2023 July 1, 2026, in accordance with the provisions of the
20	Oklahoma Sunset Law, the Board of Examiners in Optometry. This
21	Board shall consist of five (5) persons, four of whom shall possess
22	sufficient knowledge of theoretical and practical optics to practice
23	optometry, be duly licensed as optometrists, and who shall have been
24	residents of this state actually engaged in the practice of

    optometry for at least five (5) years. The term of each licensed

    optometrist member of the Board, one being appointed each year,
    shall be five (5) years, or until a qualified successor is

    appointed.
                The lay member of the Board shall serve a term

    pleasure of the Governor. The Governor is hereby authorized to

    appoint a member of the Board of Examiners in Optometry at the

    expiration of any term or whenever, for any reason, a vacancy may

    unexpired term only.
        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
