7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Historical Society;  
8 creating the Oklahoma Museum of Popular Culture  
9 Supplemental Revolving Fund; providing source of  
10 funds; providing for expenditures; requiring certain  
11 determination by the State Treasurer; requiring  
12 transfer of funds if certain determination is not  
13 made by certain date; directing transfer of funds;  
14 providing for codification; providing an effective  
15 date; and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2294.1 of Title 74, unless there  
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
21 for the Oklahoma Historical Society, to be designated the "Oklahoma  
22 Museum of Popular Culture Supplemental Revolving Fund". The fund  
23 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,  
24 and shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Historical  
Society from appropriations of the Legislature designated for  
deposit in this fund. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund

1 are hereby appropriated and shall be budgeted and expended to  
2 provide funding for repairs, planning, staging, refurbishments, and  
3 improvements to real and personal property, and funding for  
4 construction of the Oklahoma Museum of Popular Culture. No  
5 expenditures shall be made from the fund until the State Treasurer  
6 determines that funds provided by local and county governments, the  
7 federal government, or through monetary donations in the amount of  
8 Eighteen Million Dollars (\$18,000,000.00) are made for repairs,  
9 planning, staging, refurbishments, and improvements to real and  
10 personal property, and funding for construction of the Oklahoma  
11 Museum of Popular Culture; provided, no funds collected or received  
12 prior to May 25, 2023, shall be counted toward the amount.  
13 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the  
14 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the  
15 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for  
16 approval and payment. On November 15, 2025, if no determination is  
17 made by the State Treasurer pursuant to the provisions of this  
18 section authorizing expenditures from this fund, all unencumbered  
19 funds remaining in the Oklahoma Museum of Popular Culture  
20 Supplemental Revolving Fund shall be transferred to the State  
21 Treasurer for deposit in the General Revenue Fund of the State  
22 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024.

23 SECTION 2. The Director of the Office of Management and  
24 Enterprise Services shall transfer on the effective date of this act

1 the sum of Eighteen Million Dollars (\$18,000,000.00) of the funds  
2 appropriated to the Oklahoma Historical Society pursuant to Section  
3 106 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session  
4 of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature to the Oklahoma Museum of Popular  
5 Culture Supplemental Revolving Fund created in Section 1 of this  
6 act.

7 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

8 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
9 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
