7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Regents for
8 Higher Education; making an appropriation;
9 prescribing expenditures; providing an effective
10 date; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State
13 Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise
14 appropriated from the Oklahoma Capital Assets Maintenance and
15 Protection Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Fifty-six Million
16 Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$56,250,000.00) or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
18 Regents by law.

19 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated pursuant to Section 1 of
20 this act, Thirty-nine Million Three Hundred Seventy-five Thousand
21 Dollars (\$39,375,000.00) shall be expended for all four-year
22 colleges and universities except the University of Oklahoma located
23 in Norman, Oklahoma, and Oklahoma State University located in
24 Stillwater, Oklahoma, and Sixteen Million Eight Hundred Seventy-five

1 Thousand Dollars (\$16,875,000.00) shall be expended for two-year
2 institutions of higher education within The Oklahoma State System of
3 Higher Education pursuant to a plan submitted by the Oklahoma State
4 Regents for Higher Education not later than May 31, 2024, to the
5 Chair of the Appropriations Committee of the Oklahoma State Senate
6 and the Chair of the Appropriations and Budget Committee of the
7 Oklahoma House of Representatives.

8 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

9 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
