NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 30.9 of Title 74, unless there 14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 15 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund 16 for the Office of the Attorney General to be designated the "Federal 17 Overreach and Extraordinary Litigation Revolving Fund". This fund 18 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, 19 and shall consist of all monies received by the Office of the 20 Attorney General from legislative appropriations provided for the 21 purpose of representing the State of Oklahoma in cases of fighting 22 federal overreach in Oklahoma, pursuant to Enrolled House Bill No. 23
