10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4258.3 of Title 74, unless there  
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
15 for the Ethics Commission to be designated the "Ethics Commission  
16 Electronic Filing System Replacement Fund". The fund shall be a  
17 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall  
18 consist of all monies received by the Ethics Commission from  
19 legislative appropriations provided for the purpose of replacing the  
20 Ethics Commission's electronic filing system. All monies accruing  
21 to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be  
22 budgeted and expended by the Ethics Commission for the purpose  
23 provided for in this section. Expenditures from the fund shall be  
24 made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims

1 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of  
2 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

3 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Ethics  
4 Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
5 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
6 ending June 30, 2023, the sum of Two Million Four Hundred Thousand  
7 Dollars (\$2,400,000.00) to transfer to the Ethics Commission  
8 Electronic Filing System Replacement Fund created pursuant to  
9 Section 1 of this act.

10 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
11 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
