6 An Act relating to Oklahoma Petroleum Storage Tank  
7 Consolidation Act; amending 17 O.S. 2021, Section  
8 347, which relates to ethanol or methanol labeling;  
9 requiring motor fuel with certain amount of ethanol  
10 be labeled pursuant to federal requirements; and  
11 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 17 O.S. 2021, Section 347, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 347. A. No person shall sell or offer for sale motor  
16 fuel from a motor fuel dispenser supplied by a storage tank into  
17 which motor fuel that contains a mixture of at least one percent  
18 (1%) by volume of ethanol or methanol has been delivered within the  
19 sixty-day period preceding the date of sale or offer of sale unless  
20 the person prominently displays on the dispenser from which the  
21 mixture is sold a label that complies with subsection B of this  
22 section.

23 B. 1. A label as required in subsection A of this section  
24 shall:

1           ~~1.~~ a.   be displayed on each face of the motor fuel  
2                   dispenser on which the price of the motor fuel mixture  
3                   sold from the dispenser is displayed~~+~~.

4           ~~2.~~ State b.   state "Contains Ethanol" or "Contains  
5                   Methanol", as applicable~~+~~.

6           ~~3.~~ Appear c.   appear in contrasting colors with block  
7                   letters at least one-half (1/2) inch high and one-  
8                   fourth (1/4) inch wide~~+~~. and

9           ~~4.~~ Be d.   be displayed in a clear, conspicuous and  
10                  prominent manner, visible to customers using either  
11                  side of the dispenser.

12           2. If the motor fuel contains fifteen percent (15%) ethanol, a  
13 pump label as required in subsection A of this section shall meet  
14 federal E15 labeling requirements as ruled by the Environmental  
15 Protection Agency pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1090.1510 as it is written  
16 on February 1, 2023.

17           C. If a motor fuel dispenser is supplied by a storage tank into  
18 which motor fuel containing at least ten percent (10%) ethanol by  
19 volume or at least five percent (5%) methanol by volume is delivered  
20 in the sixty-day period preceding the date of the sale or offer of  
21 sale, the sign as required in subsection A of this section shall  
22 also state the percentage of ethanol or methanol by volume, to the  
23 nearest whole percent, of the motor fuel having the highest

1 percentage of ethanol or methanol delivered into that storage tank  
2 during that period.

3 D. On request by a motor fuel user, a person selling or  
4 offering for sale motor fuel from a motor fuel dispenser shall  
5 reveal:

6 1. The percentage of ethanol contained in the motor fuel being  
7 sold;

8 2. The percentage of methanol contained in the motor fuel being  
9 sold; and

10 3. If the motor fuel contains methanol, the types and  
11 percentages of associated cosolvents contained in the motor fuel  
12 being sold.

13 E. The provisions of this section shall not prohibit the  
14 posting of any other alcohol or additive information. Other alcohol  
15 or additive information and any relevant posting shall be subject to  
16 regulation by the Corporation Commission.

17 F. The Corporation Commission shall promulgate rules as  
18 necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
