16	A. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall represent
17	and protect the collective interests of military veterans in this
18	state. The Department may request the engagement of the Attorney
19	General on behalf of an individual veteran or a collective group of

21	1. Receiving a complaint of improperly withheld or revoked
22	benefits or breaches of trust in the administration of funds by the
23	United States Department of Veterans Affairs;

1	3. Determining that the Department has exhausted its ability to
2	intervene on behalf of the veteran or veterans.
3	B. Upon request from the Department pursuant to subsection A of
4	this section, the Attorney General may, at his or her discretion,
5	intervene on behalf of the veteran or veterans.
6	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
