10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:				
11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2021, Section 4303, is				
12	amended to read as follows:				
13	Section 4303. As used in the Oklahoma Quality Events Incentive				
14	Act:				
15	1. "Certified sponsor" means an entity or organization				
16	authorized to promote and conduct a quality event, which is				
17	incurring expenses for the promotion of such event to be conducted				
18	within the corporate limits of an eligible municipality or an				
19	unincorporated area within a county;				
20	2. "Economic impact study" means a study which includes:				
21	a. a description and, if applicable, history of the				
22	quality event,				
23	b. information regarding the site selection process for				
24	the quality event,

1 an estimate of the expenses anticipated to be incurred с. in connection with hosting the quality event, 2 d. an estimate of the total gross sales made by vendors 3 during any period of time during which no quality 4 5 event activity occurs, a detailed estimate of the anticipated increase in 6 e. sales tax revenue directly attributable to the quality 7 event, and 8 9 f. the general economic impact likely to occur as a result of the preparation for, occurrence of and 10 activity occurring in connection with the dissolution 11 12 of, a quality event;

3. "Eligible local support amounts" means:

- 14a.any payment made by a local government entity or15transfer of monies from the general fund or transfer16of tax revenues derived from a locally imposed tax to17a certified sponsor for the purpose of attracting,18promoting, advertising, organizing, conducting, or19otherwise supporting a quality event, or
- b. any direct payment made by a certified sponsor to a
 for-profit or nonprofit entity, other than the host
 community, for the purpose of attracting, promoting,
 advertising, organizing, conducting, or otherwise
 supporting a quality event;

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- 4. "Event history" means:
- a. historical information on the event including past
 locations of the event,
- 4 b. a description of previous attempts by the host
 5 community to secure the event,
- 6 c. information regarding attempts by other communities to
 7 recruit the event, and
- 8 d. if applicable, the competitive bidding process for
 9 securing the event by the host community;

5. "Host community" means any county, incorporated city or
 town, or any combination of counties, incorporated cities or towns
 of the state which are authorized by their respective governing
 bodies to host or assist in the presentation of a quality event;

14 6. "Incremental sales tax revenue" means the amount of 15 additional state sales tax revenue collected as a result of the 16 quality event, as determined by an economic impact study verified by 17 the Oklahoma Tax Commission;

18 7. "New event" means a quality event which did not occur within 19 a period of twenty-four (24) months prior to the month during which 20 a quality event is held;

21 8. "Quality event" means:

a. a new event or a meeting of a nationally recognized
organization or its members,

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1	b.	a new or existing event that is a national,
2		international or world championship, or
3	с.	a new or existing event that is managed or produced by
4		an Oklahoma-based national or international
5		organization <u>,</u>
6	<u>d.</u>	for counties with a population of less than one
7		hundred thousand (100,000) persons, or a city with
8		less than ten thousand (10,000) people in a county
9		with more than one hundred thousand (100,000) persons
10		according to the latest Federal Decennial Census, no
11		more than one new or existing event designated by the
12		county or city per calendar year. Provided, at least
13		twenty-five percent (25%) of attendees of the
14		designated event shall be comprised of residents from
15		outside this state, or
16	<u>e.</u>	for a combination of at least two (2) counties, towns,
17		cities, or municipalities along the route of or
18		containing within its boundaries, a National Scenic
19		Byway or State Scenic Byway, designated pursuant to
20		the National Scenic Byways Program, pursuant to 23
21		U.S.C., Section 162, one driving related event per
22		<pre>calendar year;</pre>
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9. "Recurring event" means a quality event which occurred at
 least once within the twenty-four (24) months prior to the month
 during which a quality event is held;

10. "State sales tax revenue" means the proceeds from the state
sales tax levy imposed pursuant to Section 1354 of this title upon
taxable transactions occurring as a result of the quality event, as
determined by an economic impact study verified by the Oklahoma Tax
Commission; and

9 11. "Vendors" means those persons or business entities making 10 taxable sales of tangible personal property or services as a result 11 of the quality event, as determined by an economic impact study 12 verified by the Oklahoma Tax Commission and, unless the context 13 otherwise requires, shall have the same meaning as defined by 14 Section 1352 of this title.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023. 16 17 18 19 20

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
