12	recognized as Native American Heritage Month; and

17	warriors served in World War I and ten thousand Native American
18	women joined the American Red Cross, and over forty-four thousand
19	warriors and eight hundred Native American women served in World War
20	II; and
21	WHEREAS, since 9/11, Native Americans have served at a higher
22	per capita rate than any other ethnic group; and
23	WHEREAS, the Force 50 Foundation is leading an effort to honor
24	and celebrate the Native American warrior with several events in

1	November, culminating in a special, nationally recognized event on
2	November 23, 2024.

7	as Oklahoma Native American Warrior Day, honoring all Native
8	American warriors.
9	THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature encourages all Oklahomans
10	and businesses to participate in and support appropriately the
11	efforts of the Force 50 Foundation to make all November events
12	historic and successful.
13	THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature encourages the Governor and
14	appropriate state agencies to support this historic project.
