13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-412 of Title 14A, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. If a person requests a report from a consumer reporting
18 agency in connection with a credit transaction involving any
19 extension of credit, such agency may not, solely on the basis of
20 such request, furnish a report to a third party unless such third
21 party has the consumer's consent or has a current relationship,
22 relating to credit, servicing, or other financial services, with
23 such consumer.
