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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 3A O.S. 2021, Section 201, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 201. A. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Horse
16	Racing Commission, which shall consist of the following nine (9)
17	members:
18	1. One member who shall be from the First Congressional
19	District, one member who shall be from the Fourth Congressional
20	District, and one member who shall be experienced in the horse
21	industry appointed by the Governor;
22	2. One member who shall be from the Third Congressional
23	District appointed by the Lieutenant Governor;
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- 3. One member who shall be experienced in the horse industry appointed by the Attorney General;
- 4. One member who shall be from the Second Congressional

 District and one member who shall be experienced in the horse

 industry appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of

 Representatives; and
- 5. One member who shall be from the Fifth Congressional

 District and one member who shall be experienced in the horse

 industry appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma

 State Senate.

The members shall only be appointed with the advice and consent of the Senate.

At least one member shall be appointed from each congressional district, and at least three of the remaining members shall be experienced in the horse industry and shall be appointed from the state at large. However, when When congressional districts are redrawn, each member appointed prior to July 1 of the year in which such modification becomes effective shall complete the current term of office, and appointments made after July 1 of the year in which such modification becomes effective shall be based on the redrawn districts. Appointments made after July 1 of the year in which such modification becomes effective shall be from any redrawn districts which are not represented by a board member until such time as each

- of the modified congressional districts is represented by a board member.
- B. To be eligible for appointment to the Commission, a person shall:
 - 1. Be a citizen of the United States;
 - 2. Have been a resident of this state for five (5) years immediately preceding the appointment; and
 - 3. Not have been convicted of a felony pursuant to the laws of this state, the laws of any other state, or the laws of the United States as established by a national criminal history record check as defined by Section 150.9 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
 - C. The term of office of a member of the Commission shall be for six (6) years and until a successor is appointed and qualified.
 - D. The Governor Each appointing authority may remove any the member of he or she appointed to the Commission for incompetence, neglect of duty, or malfeasance in office upon first giving the member a copy of the charges and an opportunity to be heard. A vacancy on the Commission shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment made by the Governor appropriate appointing authority.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
- 21 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 22 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
