12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 33.1 of Title 76, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. As used in this section:
17	1. "Food" means unserved perishable, salvageable food that has
18	been properly preserved for human consumption; and
19	2. "Restaurant" means any eating establishment regardless of
20	seating capacity including public school district cafeterias.
21	B. Any restaurant that, in good faith and without compensation,
22	donates food which is prepared and subsequently donated by the
23	restaurant shall not be liable for damages caused by the condition
24	of the food, unless the damages by the restaurant result from an

1	intentional act, omission, gross negligence or the restaurant knew
2	or should have known of the condition of the food that resulted in
3	the damages.
4	C. This section shall apply to all civil actions filed on or
5	after November 1, 2023.
6	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
