11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2021, Section 6-507, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 6-507. A. It shall be unlawful and a violation of the
15	Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act for any person:
16	1. To refuse an inspection authorized by the Oklahoma Farmed
17	Cervidae Act;
18	2. To commingle or integrate any native cervidae into a farmed
19	cervidae herd;
20	3. To intentionally commingle or integrate any farmed cervidae
21	with native cervidae;
22	4. To fail to maintain records as required by law;
23	5. To fail to maintain fencing as required by law;

1	6. To fail to pay any fee, fine, or penalty as required and
2	established pursuant to the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act;
3	7. To fail to comply with any State Board of Agriculture order;
4	or
5	8. To violate any provision of the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae
6	Act.
7	B. No person shall transport live cervidae into or through
8	Oklahoma unless the cervidae originate from a state that allows
9	transport of live cervidae from Oklahoma into or through that state.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
11	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
13	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
