14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 664.101 of Title 74, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Except as otherwise provided by this section, any report  
19 required or authorized by law to be filed with the Governor, the  
20 Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives or the President  
21 Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, separately or in any  
22 combination, shall be published, in full, on the website maintained  
23 by or on behalf of the Secretary of State.

1       B. Any information contained in reports as described by  
2 subsection A of this section required to be kept confidential shall  
3 be excluded or redacted from the version of the report published on  
4 the website. The entity transmitting a report which has information  
5 that needs to be excluded or redacted shall include in the  
6 transmittal document or email an identification of such material,  
7 such as an appendix, an exhibit or other information. The Secretary  
8 of State shall be responsible for identification of omitted or  
9 redacted information and for establishing a consistent and reliable  
10 method for modifying reports to avoid prohibited disclosure. The  
11 Secretary of State shall clearly identify such reports on its  
12 website as containing information omitted or redacted. The website  
13 maintained by the Secretary of State or the link to the reports  
14 shall be officially designated as the "Oklahoma Reporting  
15 Transparency Portal".

16       C. The Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of  
17 Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State  
18 Senate may transmit any report received by any of their respective  
19 offices, or a copy of such report, not later than thirty (30) days  
20 after its receipt.

21       D. For reports required to be filed with any combination of the  
22 Governor, the Speaker and the President Pro Tempore, the reporting  
23 entity shall transmit a copy of the report to the Secretary of  
24 State.
