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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5060.45 of Title 74, unless
19	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. There is hereby established the Oklahoma Accelerator Program
21	at the Oklahoma Center for Advancement of Science and Technology, to
22	be administered by the Center as a continuation of the accelerator
23	program previously administered by the Oklahoma Department of
24	Commerce. The program shall utilize appropriated funding to

leverage private capital for the purpose of stimulating growth of
early-stage startup companies throughout the state by connecting
such companies with the global entrepreneurial ecosystems required
to enhance business talent and investment opportunities.

5 Β. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Center for Advancement of Science and 6 7 Technology to be designated the "Oklahoma Accelerator Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal 8 9 year limitations. The fund shall consist of all monies authorized by law for deposit in such fund including, but not limited to gifts, 10 11 grants, private donations, private equity contributions, and fee revenues and funds by government entities authorized to provide 12 13 funding for the purposes authorized for the use of the fund. All 14 monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated 15 and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Center for the 16 Advancement of Science and Technology for purposes authorized by law 17 to implement the Oklahoma Accelerator Program. Expenditures from 18 said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer 19 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the 20 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and 21 payment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

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1	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
