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8 An Act relating to state property; creating the
9 Oklahoma Capitol Critical Infrastructure Act;
10 amending 3 O.S. 2021, Section 322, which relates to
11 critical infrastructure facilities; modifying
12 definition; amending 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1792,
13 which relates to critical infrastructure facilities;
14 modifying definition; amending 74 O.S. 2021, Section
15 1811.4C, which relates to the State Capitol Complex
16 and State Capitol Park; modifying reference to the
17 Oklahoma Administrative Code; providing for
18 noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 1811.4C, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 1811.4C A. The provisions of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
Statutes shall be applicable to all streets and highways within the
State Capitol Park in Oklahoma City and the State Capitol Complex in
Tulsa. The Department of Public Safety shall be the primary law
enforcement agency within the State Capitol Park and within the

1 State Capitol Complex, upon its establishment, and shall enforce and
2 supervise the enforcement of all parking, traffic and criminal laws
3 therein.

4 B. The rules for the "Use of ~~the~~ Public Areas of ~~the~~ Capitol
5 and Plazas" and for the "Use of ~~the~~ State Capitol Park", as
6 promulgated by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services and
7 set out in Subchapters ~~5~~ 3 and ~~7~~ 5 of Chapter ~~40~~ 60 of Title ~~580~~ 260
8 of the Oklahoma Administrative Code, are applicable to the State
9 Capitol Park and State Capitol Complex. The Department of Public
10 Safety shall have the exclusive authority to enforce these rules. A
11 violation of a rule shall be a misdemeanor and, upon conviction,
12 shall be punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding
13 one (1) year, or by a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars
14 (\$500.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

15 C. This section shall not be construed to divest the Cities of
16 Oklahoma City or Tulsa of jurisdiction relating to the enforcement
17 of any law or ordinance within said parks except the enforcement of
18 laws regarding vehicle parking which shall be vested exclusively in
19 the Department of Public Safety.

20 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
