NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7320 of Title 63, unless there 18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 19 For the purpose of prohibiting step therapy requirements for 20 certain prescription drugs to treat advanced metastatic cancer and 21 associated conditions. 22 As used in this section: 23 "Associated conditions" means the symptoms or side effects 1. 24 associated with advanced metastatic cancer or its treatment and

- which, in the judgment of the health care practitioner, will further jeopardize the health of a patient if left untreated;
 - 2. "Advanced metastatic cancer" means cancer that has spread from the primary or original site of the cancer to nearby tissues, lymph nodes, or other areas or parts of the body.
 - SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7321 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
 - A. A health benefit plan that provides coverage for advanced metastatic cancer and associated conditions may not require, before the health benefit plan provides coverage of a prescription drug approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration, that the enrollee:
 - 1. Fails to successfully respond to a different drug; or
 - 2. Proves a history of failure of a different drug.
 - B. This section applies only to a drug, the use of which is:
 - 1. Consistent with best practices for the treatment of advanced metastatic cancer or an associated condition;
 - 2. Supported by peer-reviewed, evidence-based literature; and
- 3. Approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration.
 - SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
