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15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3240.9 of Title 63, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
20 Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant Program".

21 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3420.10 of Title 63, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
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1 There is hereby created the Adolescent Psychiatric Facility
2 Grant Program which shall be administered by the Department of
3 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services. The program shall help
4 increase the number of adolescent psychiatric beds available in
5 Oklahoma. The program shall help provide funding for remodeling or
6 building out existing facility space to be used for an adolescent
7 psychiatric facility. The program shall be used for facilities
8 where a Public Trust Hospital, as defined in Sections 3250.1 through
9 3250.9 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, are donating both the
10 space and the staffing needs to support the facility. Applicants
11 shall have, in writing, the agreed upon support from the donating
12 Public Trust Hospital upon application. The location of these
13 facilities shall be in counties with a population of less than
14 forty-five thousand (45,000) people per the 2020 Federal Decennial
15 Census. The facility, upon completion, shall hold between ten and
16 twenty beds for adolescent psychiatric patients upon completion.
17 Beginning January 1, 2025, the Department of Mental Health and
18 Substance Abuse Services shall provide an annual report to the
19 Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the
20 President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, the
21 Appropriations and Budget Chair of the Oklahoma House of
22 Representatives, and the Appropriations Chair of the State Senate
23 that includes information about any grants awarded and where
24 awardees are on the completion of the projects.

1 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3240.11 of Title 63, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
5 for the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services to
6 be designated the "Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Revolving Fund".
7 The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
8 limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
9 Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services from
10 appropriations to the fund. All monies accruing to the credit of
11 said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended
12 by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services for
13 the purpose of the Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant
14 Program. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse
15 Services may retain one percent (1%) of all funds otherwise
16 deposited to the fund to cover administrative costs related to the
17 Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant Program.
18 Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by
19 the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with
20 the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
21 approval and payment.

22 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

23 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
24 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
