15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8501 of Title 74, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. Each state agency, board, commission, department, or other
19	state governmental entity with more than five hundred employees
20	shall develop and implement a system for telephone callback.
21	B. A system that allows the caller to request an automatic
22	callback as part of a menu of options for the routing or handling of
23	the call shall satisfy the requirements of this section.

1	C. The provisions of this section shall be applicable to any
2	entity that uses a toll-free number to allow contact with the
3	agency, and such system shall also provide an automatic callback
