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6	An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2021, Section 150.27, which relates to the
7	deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) laboratory of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; directing the
8 9	Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to promulgate policies, procedures, and forms for statewide rapid
9	DNA program; allowing use of Rapid DNA technology; requiring law enforcement agencies to meet certain standards; authorizing the Bureau to promulgate
10	standards, authorizing the Bureau to promulgate standards and provide certain training; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 150.27, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 150.27 A. There shall be established within the
18	Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) a deoxyribonucleic
19	acid (DNA) laboratory for the purpose of determining DNA profiles to
20	be used for evidence in criminal proceedings. The OSBI shall
21	coordinate the use of this laboratory and equipment with federal,
22	state, county, and municipal law enforcement agencies. All county
23	sheriff departments and all police departments for municipalities
24	may participate in this laboratory. The OSBI shall establish

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standards and guidelines for the deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA)
 laboratory and shall comply with any regulations applicable to DNA
 testing, sampling and laboratory standards.

B. The OSBI may make a DNA profile of any blood or saliva
specimen received for any other purpose by the Bureau and place the
DNA profile in its DNA population database. The DNA population
database shall not be indexed by donor name, and the Bureau shall
promulgate rules to protect the privacy of the DNA donors.

9 C. The OSBI may contract for the services of a Forensic DNA 10 Technical Manager as reasonably necessary to ensure the continued 11 operations of the DNA laboratory. The OSBI shall be exempt from the 12 competitive bidding requirements of the Oklahoma Central Purchasing 13 Act for the purpose of soliciting, negotiating, and effectuating 14 such a contract or contracts.

15 D. The OSBI shall promulgate necessary policies, procedures, 16 and forms for participation in a rapid DNA investigative lead 17 program, a statewide program for law enforcement agencies, outlining 18 the collection and processing of crime scene samples utilizing rapid 19 DNA instrumentation. The provisions of this subsection authorize 20 the OSBI to promulgate program parameters as well as provide the 21 procedures on technical and practical procedures for law enforcement 22 agencies concerning the training, maintenance, and use of rapid DNA 23 instruments throughout the state.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
