8	feeding operations; eliminating certain point system; and providing an effective date.
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11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2021, Section 20-25, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 20-25. A. 1. The State Board of Agriculture is
15	authorized and directed to promulgate a violation points system for
16	violating the Oklahoma Swine Feeding Operations Act which provides
17	greater punishment for violations which are intentional and for
18	violations which pose a greater threat to the environment.
19	2. The State Board of Agriculture shall have the power to
20	suspend, revoke or not renew the license of any swine feeding
21	operation based on the point system after a hearing, and after an
22	administrative determination that the swine feeding operation has
23	violated or has failed to comply with any of the provisions of the
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Oklahoma Swine Feeding Operations Act, or any rule promulgated
 pursuant thereto.

3 3. 2. The Board shall have the power and duty to reinstate any 4 such suspended or revoked licenses, or renew the licenses, upon a 5 satisfactory and acceptable showing and assurance that the swine 6 feeding operation conducted swine feeding operations in conformity 7 with, and in compliance with, the provisions of the Oklahoma Swine 8 Feeding Operations Act and rules promulgated pursuant thereto, and 9 that conformity and compliance will be continuous.

B. In order to protect the public health and safety and the environment of this state, the Board, pursuant to the Oklahoma Swine Feeding Operations Act, may deny issuance of a license or transfer of a license to establish and operate a swine feeding operation on and after September 1, 1997, to any person or other legal entity which:

Is not in substantial compliance with a final agency order
 or any final order or judgment of a court of record secured by any
 state or federal agency relating to swine feeding operations; or

Has evidenced a reckless disregard for the protection of the
 public and the environment as demonstrated by a history of
 noncompliance with environmental laws and rules resulting in
 endangerment of human health or the environment.

C. Any action taken in regard to the denial, suspension or revocation of a license shall be in conformity with the rules of the

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Board governing Administrative Procedures and the Administrative
 Procedures Act.

3 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2021, Section 20-61, is 4 amended to read as follows:

Section 20-61. A. 1. The Board is authorized and directed to promulgate a violation points system for violating the Oklahoma Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations Act which provides greater punishment for violations which are intentional and for violations which pose a greater threat to the environment.

10 2. The State Board of Agriculture shall have the power to 11 suspend, revoke or not renew the license of any animal feeding 12 operation based on the point system after a hearing, and after an 13 administrative determination that the animal feeding operation has 14 violated or has failed to comply with any of the provisions of the 15 Oklahoma Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations Act, or any rule 16 promulgated pursuant thereto.

17 3. 2. The Board shall have the power and duty to reinstate any 18 such suspended or revoked licenses, or renew the licenses, upon a 19 satisfactory and acceptable showing and assurance that the animal 20 feeding operation conducted animal feeding operations in conformity 21 with, and in compliance with, the provisions of the Oklahoma 22 Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations Act and rules promulgated 23 pursuant thereto, and that such conformity and compliance will be 24 continuous.

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B. In order to protect the public health and safety and the
environment of this state, the Board, pursuant to the Oklahoma
Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations Act, may deny issuance of a
license or transfer of a license to establish and operate an animal
feeding operation on and after September 1, 1997, to any person or
other legal entity which:

Is not in substantial compliance with a final agency order
 or any final order or judgment of a court of record secured by any
 state or federal agency relating to animal feeding operations; or

10 2. Has evidenced a reckless disregard for the protection of the 11 public and the environment as demonstrated by a history of 12 noncompliance with environmental laws and rules resulting in 13 endangerment of human health or the environment.

14 C. Any action taken in regard to the denial, suspension or 15 revocation of a license shall be in conformity with the rules of the 16 Board governing Administrative Procedures and the Administrative 17 Procedures Act.

18 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
