L 6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:	
L7	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified	
L8	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6971 of Title 36, unless there	
L 9	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:	
20	A. As used in this section:	
21	1. "Durable medical equipment" means equipment as defined	
22	pursuant to paragraph 2 of Section 375.2 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma	
23	Statutes;	

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2. "Health benefit plan" means a health benefit plan as defined pursuant to subsection C of Section 6060.4 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

- 3. "Health care provider" means a provider as defined pursuant to Section 6571 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 4. "Health maintenance organization" or "HMO" means a health maintenance organization as defined pursuant to paragraph 12 of Section 6902 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and
- 5. "Preferred provider organization" or "PPO" means a preferred provider organization as defined pursuant to paragraph 8 of Section 6054 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- B. No health benefit plan, HMO, PPO, or other provider network authorized to administer health care coverage in this state shall refuse coverage to an insured for durable medical equipment and supplies as prescribed by a health care provider, regardless of whether they are in-network or out-of-network, unless there is an Oklahoma-licensed in-network provider within a fifty-mile radius of the patient's five-digit ZIP code that can provide an in-person evaluation for the prescribed medical equipment or supplies.
- C. If a health care provider deems it necessary that an insured receive covered medical equipment or supplies within twenty-four (24) hours, a health benefit plan, HMO, or PPO shall cover such equipment and supplies from any health care provider of the

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insured's choosing who can provide the necessary equipment and supplies within the requested timeframe.

D. When covered medical equipment or supplies are not available in network, the health benefit plan, HMO, or PPO shall reimburse an out-of-network provider at the same rate and benefit level for the provided equipment or supplies as an in-network provider for the health benefit plan, HMO, PPO, or other provider network authorized to administer health care coverage in this state.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
