FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to advisory committees of licensing boards; amending 59 O.S. 2021, Sections 2305 and 3005, which relate to advisory committees of the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision; eliminating termination dates of committees; updating statutory language; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 2305, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2305. A. There is hereby ~~re-created, to continue until~~  
~~July 1, 2024, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma~~  
~~Sunset Law,~~ established an Advisory Committee on Pedorthics, which shall consist of five (5) voting members to be appointed by the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision to three-year terms ending December 31; provided, initial appointments shall be staggered such that two members are appointed for one (1) year, two

1 members are appointed for two (2) years, and one member is appointed  
2 for three (3) years.

3 B. One member shall be a licensed physician who is a member of  
4 the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision. One member  
5 shall be a physician licensed to practice podiatric medicine by the  
6 Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners. One member shall be a member  
7 of the public who is a consumer of pedorthic services. Two members  
8 shall be pedorthists certified by the American Board for  
9 Certification in Orthotics, Prosthetics and Pedorthics or  
10 pedorthists licensed by the State Board of Medical Licensure and  
11 Supervision.

12 C. Members shall serve until their successors are appointed and  
13 qualified; provided, no member shall serve more than eight (8)  
14 consecutive years or two full terms, whichever is greater.

15 D. The Committee shall annually elect a chair and ~~vice-chair~~  
16 vice chair from among the members. The chair or ~~vice-chair~~ vice  
17 chair and two other members shall constitute a quorum. Members  
18 shall be reimbursed from funds available to the State Board of  
19 Medical Licensure and Supervision pursuant to the State Travel  
20 Reimbursement Act.

21 E. 1. The Committee shall advise the Board on matters  
22 pertaining to pedorthics, including but not limited to:

23 a. scope and standards of practice,  
24

- b. licensure and registration requirements, examination requirements, exceptions thereto, renewal requirements, temporary licensure or registration, and endorsement or reciprocity requirements,
- c. methods and requirements for ensuring the continued competence of licensed and registered persons,
- d. grounds for probation, revocation or suspension of license or registration, reinstatement provisions,
- e. fees, and
- f. all other matters which may pertain to the practice of pedorthics.

2. The Committee shall review and make recommendations to the Board on all applications for licensure and registration.

3. The Committee shall assist and advise the Board in all hearings related to the enforcement of the Oklahoma Licensed Pedorthists Act.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 3005, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3005. A. There is hereby ~~re-created, to continue until July 1, 2024, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law,~~ established an Advisory Committee on Orthotics and Prosthetics, which shall consist of seven (7) voting members to be appointed by the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision to three-year terms ending December 31; provided, initial appointments

1 shall be staggered such that two members are appointed for one (1)  
2 year, two members are appointed for two (2) years, and three members  
3 are appointed for three (3) years.

4 B. One member shall be a licensed physician who is a member of  
5 the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision. Two members  
6 shall be lay persons who are consumers of orthotic or prosthetic  
7 services. Two members shall be licensed orthotists, not more than  
8 one of whom may also be a licensed prosthetist. Two members shall  
9 be licensed prosthetists, not more than one of whom may also be a  
10 licensed orthotist; provided, licensure under the Orthotics and  
11 Prosthetics Practice Act not being possible until the act is  
12 implemented, two of the initial appointees to positions requiring  
13 licensure as an orthotist or prosthetist shall, in lieu of  
14 licensure, be certified by the American Board for Certification in  
15 Orthotics, Prosthetics and Pedorthics and two shall be certified in  
16 orthotics or prosthetics by the Board ~~for Orthotist/Prosthetist~~  
17 ~~Certification~~ of Certification/Accreditation.

18 C. Members shall serve until their successors are appointed and  
19 qualified; provided, no member shall serve more than eight (8)  
20 consecutive years or two full terms, whichever is greater.

21 D. The Committee shall annually elect a chair and ~~vice-chair~~  
22 vice chair from among the members required to be licensed. The  
23 chair or ~~vice-chair~~ vice chair and three other members shall  
24 constitute a quorum. Members shall be reimbursed from funds

1 available to the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision  
2 pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

3 E. 1. The Committee shall advise the Board on matters  
4 pertaining to orthotics and prosthetics, including, but not limited  
5 to:

- 6 a. scope and standards of practice,
- 7 b. licensure and registration requirements, examination  
8 requirements, exceptions thereto, renewal  
9 requirements, temporary licensure or registration, and  
10 endorsement or reciprocity requirements,
- 11 c. methods and requirements for ensuring the continued  
12 competence of licensed and registered persons,
- 13 d. grounds for probation, revocation, or suspension of  
14 license or registration, reinstatement provisions,
- 15 e. fees, and
- 16 f. all other matters which may pertain to the practice of  
17 orthotics or prosthetics.

18 2. The Committee shall review and make recommendations to the  
19 Board on all applications for licensure and registration.

20 3. The Committee shall assist and advise the Board in all  
21 hearings related to the enforcement of the Orthotics and Prosthetics  
22 Practice Act.

23 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

1       SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
