11	3005, which relate to advisory committees of the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision;
12	eliminating termination dates of committees; updating statutory language; providing an effective date; and
13	declaring an emergency.
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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 2305, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 2305. A. There is hereby <del>re-created, to continue until</del>
19	July 1, 2024, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma
20	Sunset Law, established an Advisory Committee on Pedorthics, which
21	shall consist of five (5) voting members to be appointed by the
22	State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision to three-year terms
23	ending December 31; provided, initial appointments shall be
24	staggered such that two members are appointed for one (1) year, two

1 | members are appointed for two (2) years, and one member is appointed 2 | for three (3) years.

- B. One member shall be a licensed physician who is a member of the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision. One member shall be a physician licensed to practice podiatric medicine by the Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners. One member shall be a member of the public who is a consumer of pedorthic services. Two members shall be pedorthists certified by the <a href="American">American</a> Board for Certification in <a href="Orthotics">Orthotics</a>, <a href="Prosthetics">Prosthetics</a> and <a href="Pedorthics">Pedorthics</a> or <a href="pedorthists">pedorthists</a> licensed by the State Board of Medical Licensure and <a href="Supervision">Supervision</a>.
- C. Members shall serve until their successors are appointed and qualified; provided, no member shall serve more than eight (8) consecutive years or two full terms, whichever is greater.
- D. The Committee shall annually elect a chair and vice-chair vice chair from among the members. The chair or vice-chair vice chair and two other members shall constitute a quorum. Members shall be reimbursed from funds available to the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act.
- E. 1. The Committee shall advise the Board on matters pertaining to pedorthics, including but not limited to:
  - a. scope and standards of practice,

- b. licensure and registration requirements, examination
  requirements, exceptions thereto, renewal
  requirements, temporary licensure or registration, and
  endorsement or reciprocity requirements,
  - c. methods and requirements for ensuring the continued competence of licensed and registered persons,
  - d. grounds for probation, revocation or suspension of license or registration, reinstatement provisions,
  - e. fees, and

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- f. all other matters which may pertain to the practice of pedorthics.
- 2. The Committee shall review and make recommendations to the Board on all applications for licensure and registration.
- 3. The Committee shall assist and advise the Board in all hearings related to the enforcement of the Oklahoma Licensed Pedorthists Act.
- 17 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 3005, is
  18 amended to read as follows:
- Section 3005. A. There is hereby re-created, to continue until

  July 1, 2024, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma

  Sunset Law, established an Advisory Committee on Orthotics and

  Prosthetics, which shall consist of seven (7) voting members to be

  appointed by the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision to

  three-year terms ending December 31; provided, initial appointments

  are appointed for three (3) years.
- One member shall be a licensed physician who is a member of 5 the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision. Two members shall be lay persons who are consumers of orthotic or prosthetic 6 Two members shall be licensed orthotists, not more than services. one of whom may also be a licensed prosthetist. Two members shall 9 be licensed prosthetists, not more than one of whom may also be a licensed orthotist; provided, licensure under the Orthotics and 10 Prosthetics Practice Act not being possible until the act is 11 12 implemented, two of the initial appointees to positions requiring licensure as an orthotist or prosthetist shall, in lieu of 13 licensure, be certified by the American Board for Certification in 14 Orthotics, Prosthetics and Pedorthics and two shall be certified in 15 orthotics or prosthetics by the Board for Orthotist/Prosthetist 16 Certification of Certification/Accreditation. 17
  - C. Members shall serve until their successors are appointed and qualified; provided, no member shall serve more than eight (8) consecutive years or two full terms, whichever is greater.

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D. The Committee shall annually elect a chair and vice-chair vice chair from among the members required to be licensed. The chair or vice-chair vice chair and three other members shall constitute a quorum. Members shall be reimbursed from funds

available to the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

- E. 1. The Committee shall advise the Board on matters pertaining to orthotics and prosthetics, including, but not limited to:
  - a. scope and standards of practice,
  - b. licensure and registration requirements, examination requirements, exceptions thereto, renewal requirements, temporary licensure or registration, and endorsement or reciprocity requirements,
  - c. methods and requirements for ensuring the continued competence of licensed and registered persons,
  - d. grounds for probation, revocation, or suspension of license or registration, reinstatement provisions,
  - e. fees, and

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- f. all other matters which may pertain to the practice of orthotics or prosthetics.
- 2. The Committee shall review and make recommendations to the Board on all applications for licensure and registration.
- 3. The Committee shall assist and advise the Board in all hearings related to the enforcement of the Orthotics and Prosthetics Practice Act.
- SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

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SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
