15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:						
L 6	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified						
L7	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1239 of Title 69, unless there						
L8	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:						
L 9	A. For the purposes of this section:						
20	1. "Harmful woody species" means a tree or shrub species that						
21	is rapidly encroaching into adjoining lands and is likely to cause						
22	harm to the environment or economy. Harmful woody species include						
23	but are not limited to:						
2.4	a. Juniperus ashei or the ashe juniper,						

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b. Juniperus monosperma or the oneseed juniper,

- c. Juniperus pinchotii or the redberry juniper,
- d. Juniperus scopulorum or the Rocky Mountain juniper,
- e. Juniperus virginiana or the Eastern redcedar,
- f. Prosopis glandulosa or the honey mesquite, and
- g. Tamarix ramosissima or the salt cedar; and
- 2. "Qualified landowner" means a person who has eradicated or is currently eradicating harmful woody species on his or her property and has notified his or her local conservation district of such eradication efforts.
- B. A local conservation district that receives notice from a qualified landowner of eradication efforts on his or her property shall forward such notice to the Oklahoma Conservation Commission.

  The Oklahoma Conservation Commission shall notify the Department of Transportation or the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority, whichever has the responsibility of maintaining the right-of-way adjacent to the property of the qualified landowner, and advise on recommended plans for eradication of harmful woody species on such right-of-way.
- C. The Department of Transportation or the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority shall eradicate all harmful woody species on the right-of-way within one hundred (100) yards on any side that adjoins the property of a qualified landowner within one (1) year of receiving notification from the Oklahoma Conservation Commission of the eradication efforts of a qualified landowner.
