18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 3601.1, as

21	Section 3601.1 A. For purposes of Sections 3601.1 through 3603		
22	of this title, the term "employee" means a full-time employee or any

include temporary employees working on a seasonal basis between May
 and October 31.

8 C. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise 9 prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the 10 Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System Board of Trustees by law 11 shall be set by the Board of Trustees.

D. Temporary employees of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle, Dismantler, and Manufactured Housing Commission between the dates of November 1 and January 31 annually shall not be counted toward the maximum number of full-time-equivalent employees provided for in this section.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
