8	AS INTRODUCED
9	An Act relating to agriculture; amending 2 O.S. 2021, Section 6-507, which relates to the Oklahoma Farmed
10	Cervidae Act violations; removing prohibition against interstate transportation without a reciprocal
11	agreement; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2021, Section 6-507, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 6-507. A. It shall be unlawful and a violation of the
18	Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act for any person:
19	1. To refuse an inspection authorized by the Oklahoma Farmed
20	Cervidae Act;
21	2. To commingle or integrate any native cervidae into a farmed
22	cervidae herd;
23	3. To intentionally commingle or integrate any farmed cervidae
24	with native cervidae;

1	4. To fail to maintain records as required by law;
2	5. To fail to maintain fencing as required by law;
3	6. To fail to pay any fee, fine, or penalty as required and
4	established pursuant to the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act;
5	7. To fail to comply with any State Board of Agriculture order;
6	or
7	8. To violate any provision of the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae
8	Act.
9	B. No person shall transport live cervidae into or through
10	Oklahoma unless the cervidae originate from a state that allows
11	transport of live cervidae from Oklahoma into or through that state.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
13	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
15	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
