9	An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2021,
10	Section 6-101.25, which relates to recommendations of the superintendent; including additional situations
11	certain recommendations for revoking licenses may be made; describing said situations; and providing an
12	effective date.
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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-101.25, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 6-101.25 A. Whenever a superintendent decides to
18	recommend that a teacher employed within the school district be
19	dismissed or not reemployed, the superintendent shall state the
20	recommendation in writing, setting forth the basis for the
21	recommendation, and shall submit such recommendation to the board of
22	education.
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If the teacher subject to such recommendation is a career
 teacher, the recommendation shall specify the statutory grounds for
 which the recommendation is based.

If the teacher subject to such recommendation is a probationary teacher, the recommendation shall specify the cause for which the recommendation is based.

7 The superintendent shall also specify the underlying facts8 supporting the recommendation.

9 Β. If the recommendation includes grounds that could form the basis of criminal charges sufficient to result in the denial or 10 11 revocation of a certificate for a reason set forth in subparagraph a 12 of paragraph 6 of Section 3-104 of this title, or if the 13 recommendation includes a reason set forth in subparagraph a of 14 paragraph 6 of Section 3-104 of this title and is based on an 15 agreement between the teacher and school district to avoid civil 16 litigation or a settlement of a civil action unless the court orders 17 the terms of such settlement to be kept confidential, a copy of the 18 recommendation shall also be forwarded to the State Board of 19 Education after the completion of due process procedures pursuant to 20 Section 6-101.26 of this title or after the teacher resigns. 21 Failure to forward a copy of the recommendation to the State Board 22 of Education shall not be the basis for any claim or action against 23 a public school, its board of education, employees, agents or other 24 representatives. If the school district forwards a copy of the

1 recommendation to the State Board of Education, the school district 2 shall contemporaneously forward a copy to the teacher subject to 3 such recommendation. The teacher may provide supplementary 4 information to the State Board of Education.

5 C. Only school districts may request a copy of the recommendation from the State Board of Education, and only if a 6 7 teacher is being considered for new employment or a teacher is currently employed by the requesting school district. 8 The State 9 Board of Education shall notify the teacher subject to the 10 recommendation if such a request is made and provide the identity of 11 the school district that made such request. The State Board of 12 Education shall provide the requesting school district documents 13 related to the recommendation as well as any supplementary 14 information provided by the teacher subject to the recommendation, 15 and copies shall be contemporaneously forwarded to the teacher 16 subject to the recommendation. Records provided to a requesting 17 school district pursuant to this subsection shall be kept 18 confidential.

D. Except as provided for in subsection C of this section, the
State Board of Education shall keep recommendations submitted
pursuant to subsection B of this section confidential. Records
created pursuant to this section shall not be subject to disclosure
under the Oklahoma Open Records Act.

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1	E. If the State Board of Education or a school district that
2	generated or received documents pursuant to subsection C of this
3	section is served a subpoena requesting disclosure of the documents,
4	the teacher subject to the recommendation shall immediately be
5	notified and be provided the opportunity to object to the subpoena.
6	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
