12	preparation and submission of certain report; providing for codification; and providing an

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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1086.7 of Title 82, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. The Oklahoma Flood and Drought Management Task Force is
20	hereby established and shall be comprised of two groups, the
21	management group and the advisory group.
22	B. 1. The management group shall be comprised of designees
23	from the following state agencies:
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1	a.	the Oklahoma Water Resources Board, which shall serve
2		as the lead agency,
3	b.	the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management and
4		Homeland Security,
5	с.	the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
6		Forestry,
7	d.	the State Department of Health,
8	e.	the Department of Environmental Quality,
9	f.	the Oklahoma Conservation Commission,
10	g.	the Department of Wildlife Conservation,
11	h.	the Oklahoma Climatological Survey, and
12	i.	the Oklahoma Military Department.
13	2. The ac	lvisory group shall be comprised of designees of the
14	following stat	e associations and entities:
15	a.	Association of County Commissioners of Oklahoma,
16	b.	Oklahoma Rural Water Association, and
17	С.	Oklahoma Municipal League.
18	The adviso	ory group shall also include the resources of all
19	remaining stat	e agencies and departments available to provide advice
20	and assistance	e to the Oklahoma Flood and Drought Management Task
21	Force, includi	ng the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.
22	C. The Oł	alahoma Water Resources Board shall formally coordinate
23	with the follo	owing federal agencies:
24	1. Federa	al Emergency Management Agency (FEMA);

D. The Oklahoma Flood and Drought Management Task Force shall	
15 have the following duties:	
16 1. Developing and recommending state drought and flood	
17 response, recovery, and mitigation initiatives for conditions	
18 determined to be detrimental to the state economy and public healt	h;
19 2. Identifying drought and flood management areas in the stat	e;
20 3. Providing coordination and communication among federal,	
21 state, and local entities as deemed appropriate for drought and	
22 flood assistance programs, education, and information; and	
23 4. Performing such other drought- and flood-related assessmen	ts
24 and response functions as deemed necessary.	

1	E. Beginning in 2025, and every ten (10) years thereafter, in
2	conjunction with the update of the Oklahoma Comprehensive Water Plan
3	and State Flood Plan, the Oklahoma Water Resources Board shall
4	coordinate with Oklahoma Flood and Drought Management Task Force to
5	update the Oklahoma Drought Management Plan.
6	F. The Oklahoma Water Resources Board shall prepare an annual
7	update of drought and flood conditions within the state and planning
8	and mitigation activities being conducted by the Task Force and
9	shall submit such report to the Speaker of the Oklahoma House and
10	President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
