NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 15-133 of Title 47, unless there 15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 For the purpose of this section, "motorcycle profiling" means 17 the discriminatory use of the fact that a person rides a motorcycle 18 or wears motorcycle-related paraphernalia as a factor in deciding to 19 stop and question, take enforcement action, arrest, or search a 20 person or vehicle with or without a legal basis under the United 2.1 States Constitution or the Oklahoma State Constitution. 22 Every law enforcement agency in this state shall be required to: 23 1. Adopt a written policy designed to condemn and prevent 24 motorcycle profiling; and

1	2. Review and audit their existing procedures, practices, and
2	training.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
