7 An Act relating to motorcycles; defining term;
8 requiring law enforcement agencies to adopt policy,
9 review training and address issues pertaining to
10 motorcycle profiling; providing for codification; and
11 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 15-133 of Title 47, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 For the purpose of this section, "motorcycle profiling" means
17 the discriminatory use of the fact that a person rides a motorcycle
18 or wears motorcycle-related paraphernalia as a factor in deciding to
19 stop and question, take enforcement action, arrest, or search a
20 person or vehicle with or without a legal basis under the United
21 States Constitution or the Oklahoma State Constitution.

22 Every law enforcement agency in this state shall be required to:

23 1. Adopt a written policy designed to condemn and prevent
24 motorcycle profiling; and

1 2. Review and audit their existing procedures, practices, and
2 training.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
