12 An Act relating to judicial compensation; rejecting
13 and amending judicial salaries established by the
14 Board on Judicial Compensation; establishing increase
15 for certain categories of judges; maintaining salary
16 for certain categories of judges and justices;
17 establishing date of implementation; providing for
18 noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
20 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

21 Pursuant to the authority provided in Section 3.2 of Title 20 of
22 the Oklahoma Statutes to reject judicial salaries established by the
23 Board on Judicial Compensation, the Oklahoma Legislature hereby

1 rejects the Final Report of the Board on Judicial Compensation
2 issued on September 19, 2023.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
4 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

5 The Oklahoma Legislature hereby amends judicial salaries to take
6 effect July 1, 2024. The amended salary schedule provided for in
7 this section provides a salary increase of seven percent (7.0%)
8 above the salary levels existing during fiscal year 2024 for
9 positions listed as follows; all other judicial salaries shall
10 remain at the levels that existed as of January 1, 2024:

11 District Judges

12 Associate District Judges

13 Special District Judges.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
