9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Corporation
11 Commission; requiring courier application services
12 and restaurants have certain agreement; allowing for
13 filing of certain complaint; requiring Oklahoma
14 Corporation Commission follow certain protocol and
15 fee schedule; providing for codification; and
16 providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1076 of Title 47, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 Every courier application service, as defined in Section 1071 of
22 Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall have an agreement with a
23 restaurant in order to transport for delivery. If no agreement is
24 in place, the restaurant may file a complaint with the Consumer
 Services Division of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission. The

1 Commission shall follow the current protocol and fine schedule for
2 violations of this section.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
