16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1076 of Title 47, unless there
19	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	Every courier application service, as defined in Section 1071 of
21	Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall have an agreement with a
22	restaurant in order to transport for delivery. If no agreement is
23	in place, the restaurant may file a complaint with the Consumer
24	Services Division of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission. The

1	Commission shall follow the current protocol and fine schedule for
2	violations of this section.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
