14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-163 of Title 37A, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	Holders of a license issued by the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage
19	Laws Enforcement Commission pursuant to Title 37A of the Oklahoma
20	Statutes shall not be required by state law, administrative rule, or
21	regulation from checking identification (ID) cards prior to selling
22	or serving alcoholic beverages to a person. A license holder upon
23	their discretion may still choose to check and verify a person's ID
24	prior to selling or serving a person an alcoholic beverage.

1	Nothing in this section shall absolve the license holder from
2	the prohibition of selling or serving alcoholic beverages to a
3	person under twenty-one (21)years of age.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
