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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
20	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9301 of Title 74, unless there
22	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	A. There is hereby created a Telecommunications Division within
24	the Oklahoma Department of Transportation.

- B. The Director of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall assign qualified personnel to staff and manage the Telecommunications Division.
- C. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall promulgate rules and regulations to implement the creation of the Division and to carry out the duties described in section 2 of this act.
- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9302 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. The Telecommunications Division shall initiate a feasibility study to assess the creation of a statewide interoperable radio network and facilitate access for state agencies, counties, municipalities, tribal governments, and schools.
- B. The Division shall issue a request for proposal to hire a consultant to conduct the feasibility study. The Request for Proposal shall outline the objectives, scope, and requirements of the study.
- C. The feasibility study shall focus on evaluating the technical and logistical aspects of enabling access to state-funded radio towers and the creation of a statewide interoperable radio network system to enhance public safety communications.
- D. The Division shall develop and implement a timeline for the feasibility study and subsequent actions.

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1	E. By July 1, 2025, the Division shall provide a report on the
2	progress of the feasibility study and recommendations to the
3	Oklahoma Senate and the Oklahoma House of Representatives.
4	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
