As used in this act, "hospice care" means a comprehensive, 18 holistic program of palliative and/or comfort care and support provided to the member and his or her family when a physician 19 certifies that the member has a terminal illness and has a life 20 21 expectancy of six (6) months or less. 22 1. Hospice services must be related to the palliation and 23 management of the member's illness, symptom control, or to enable 24
