NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives hereby proclaims the week of April 23 through April 29, 2023, as National Crime Victims' Rights Week and proclaims Wednesday, April 26, 2023, as Victims' Rights Day.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives shall join efforts with advocacy organizations throughout the state of Oklahoma to continue recognizing and supporting victims' rights.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives reaffirms its commitment to help protect the rights of all Oklahoma crime victims, year-round.
