## 1 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES - FLOOR VERSION 2 STATE OF OKLAHOMA 1st Session of the 59th Legislature (2023) 3 4 HOUSE RESOLUTION 1017 By: Waldron 5 6 7 AS INTRODUCED A Resolution commending Hmong Special Guerilla Unit 8 (SGU) Veterans; and directing distribution. 9 10 11 WHEREAS, Hmong Special Guerilla Unit (SGU) Veterans Recognition 12 Day commemorates Hmong combat soldiers that served under the 1.3 direction of United States military and clandestine forces from 14 1961-1975, in the Secret War of Laos during the Vietnam War; and 15 WHEREAS, we recognize the contributions Hmong Veterans of 16 America continue to make to keep our cherished liberties alive; and 17 WHEREAS, the Hmong SGU veterans were vital in the Secret War in 18 Laos, providing intelligence and troops to one of the nation's 19 largest operations, rescuing American soldiers, and blocking North 20 Vietnam from using the Ho-Chi Minh Trail to South Vietnam; and 2.1 WHEREAS, it is estimated that at least 35,000 Hmong SGU veterans 22 were killed during the Secret War, and the remaining Hmong 23 population in Laos have been victims of ongoing retaliation, murder, 24 and genocide since the conclusion of the war; and

1	WHEREAS, on May 14, 1975, the last American Central Intelligence
2	Agency personnel withdrew from Laos, and the Hmong veterans and
3	their families began their journey to new beginnings; and
4	WHEREAS, these veterans and their families were provided with
5	political asylum, refugee status, and citizenship because of their
6	unique contribution to the United States.
7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
8	OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
9	THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives recognizes May 15 as
10	Hmong Special Guerilla Unit (SGU) Veterans Recognition Day in
11	Oklahoma.
12	THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Oklahoma
13	Hmong Association, President Cher J. Lor and Mrs. Moua Yang; the Lao
14	Veterans Association; the National Hmong Associations: Hmong 18 Clan
